- U.C.C.S. completed the program plan and project budget for the center in cooperation with Penrose St. Francis Centura Health (who is now the partner in development and operation of the William J Hybl Sports Medicine & Performance Center);
- The Centura Health board officially approved partnership July 2017;
- CU Board of Regents approved the 104,000 GSF facility at a cost of 61.4 million dollars June 2017;
- Capital Development committee through the general assembly approved the spending authority for the 61.4 million dollars July 2017;
- Architectural design/build team selection completed October 2017;
- Schematic Design completed July 2018;
- Commencement of Substantial Work began November 2018;
