Adult Education, serving patrons 17 years or older with numerous offerings designed to help them work toward their goals. Programs include English as a Second Language (reading and writing), High School Diploma equivalency test (GED/HiSET) preparation, Career Navigation coaching, Path to Citizenship study groups, Adult Computer Skills courses, and Food Industry Training to help students learn to be line cooks or prep cooks.
